

Coronavirus (COVID-19) catch-up premium

This plan will be subsumed within the school's raising achievement plan. Many actions included in the school's raising achievement plan will also help students to catch up following the national lockdown. These are the specific items highlighting where they have been funded by catch up funding and are additional to previous academic years. All interventions consider whether students are disadvantaged, are part of the schools target group of students and how they have been impacted by Covid.
